On behalf of the Carbon County Commissioners, we appreciate the opportunity to review and comment on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS). Carbon County believes that the Uinta Basin Railway project will fill a gap in major infrastructure that will help develop and diversify the regional economy.
